The second stage of the competition held in the second term. The second term inter-school stage comprised contestants from all 28 FAs and saw 8 schools emerge as

qualifiers for the third term final round, which held on Friday, 17th May, 2024.

At the conclusion of the event, the contestants from FA Kubwa emerged the winner for the 2023/2024 session's competition, while the contestants from FA Abakaliki and FA Ogba emerged second and third position winners respectively.

The 2024 edition was a three-staged competition which started in the first term of the 2023/2024 academic session with over 1,000, JS2 and 470, SS2 students registering from across the 28 FA Schools.

The competition began with the first round CBT where all FA schools presented their students!

577 JS2 and 382 SS2 qualifiers emerged for the second round of the competition which held in the second term of the 2023/2024 academic session.

The final round was a two-staged competition: the first stage was a CBT screening for the 87 and 29 finalists from the junior and senior categories respectively. In the second stage of the final round, the top six qualifiers for both junior and senior categories participated in a live quiz session which held in Covenant University Secondary School (CUSS).

The overall winners are OBIARAERI OBIANUJU JOSEPHINE of Faith Academy Canaanland, Ota (junior category) and ANYILA MIMIDOO PEACE PELUMI of Faith Academy Gowon Estate Lagos (senior category).

There are various prizes, scholarship awards for the winners (1st, 2nd and 3rd) in the junior and senior categories. The runner-ups and the schools producing the winners are also to receive amazing prizes!

We thank God for the success of this year’s edition and look forward to a greater and exciting competition in the next academic session!
